

DREAM GARDEN ASK QUESTIONS WHEN DESIGNING A GARDEN

questions for the client...

When designing an area of greenery, it is important that you ask the investor questions about what he or she likes and needs, so that the space created by you is on its measure.

Ask questions that you will ask at the first meeting regarding the garden project.

Forms of questions for example: What do you want to have in the garden ...?, What are you planning ...?, What are you going to do ...? What do you prefer ...? How do you imagine your garden ...?

Examples of questions for your garden designer: What's your area of specialism? How much will it cost? What should I consider when landscaping from scratch? What kind of garden theme should I have? What installations work best in low maintenance gardens? What installations would you recommend for a small garden versus a large garden?

shape of space
(garden style, historical
style, modern, straight
lines, free lines,

ecology)

equipment

(small garden architecture, water form in the garden, use of decorative and functional elements)

plants

(how much time someone has for gardening, flowers, large or small trees and shrubs, deciduous or coniferous, favorite colors)
